



Dear Parents and Guardians,

The audition for the Missoula Children's Theatre production of *Johnny Appleseed* will be held on **Monday May 8th at 4:15pm at the Episcopal Hall** (210 Courthouse Dr). There are roles for those students in Kindergarten during the 2023 school year through 8th Grade. Approximately 50-60 local students will be cast to appear in the show with the MCT Tour Actor/Director. Up to 4 students will be cast as Assistant Directors. **Registration to participate will open on April 1st, 2023. To register your child email salmonartscouncil@gmail.com with the Names and Ages of your children. You will receive a confirmation email within 48 hours to notify you of acceptance. Spaces will be filled on a first come first served order.**

Once you receive your confirmation email please note that your child will still audition for a role. This is a group audition—**no advance preparation is necessary**, but a smile never hurts. Students should just be ready to come and have a good time!

Rehearsals will be conducted every day from 4:15 pm to 8:15pm at the Episcopal Hall. Although not all cast members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role and be available for all scheduled performances. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the audition. Cast members scheduled for the full 4 hours and 15 minutes will be asked to bring a sack lunch, dinner or snack to be eaten during the 15-minute break between sessions.

The performances will be held on Saturday May 13th at noon and 5 pm and will be presented at Pioneer Elementary (900 Sharkey St).
